SIGNS THAT ARE PERMITTED

A reminder to all BIA Members that all businesses in Toronto are responsible for complying with the City's By-law. It has come to our attention that by-law officers have requested some of our businesses to turn off their LED Signs. We are currently working with the Deputy Mayor, Vincent Crisanti, to resolve this issue, LED signs have never been permitted in the City of Toronto and this is an issue that will be reviewed later this year at Council. Below is list of which signs are permitted and which signs are not:

Signs that are permitted

- Wall Sign
- Ground Sign
- Projecting Sign

If you want to display a sign for your business, a sign permit is required in most cases. To check if your sign needs a permit please contact the Sign By-law Unit at (416) 392-4249 or by e-mail at gcrompt@toronto.ca.

Signs not permitted

- Signs attached to a tree or a fence
- · Signs on parked vehicle or trailer
- Signs attached to electrical, lighting, or telephone post
- Signs which move such as flags or banners
- Signs on exterior walls or hanging in windows that display copy electronically (LED displays)

Signs that do not comply will be subject to a Notice of violation and subsequent enforcement action including charges, court appearance and/or removal of the signs at the expense of the owner.

RED LIGHT CAMERA

As part of 5 year contract, our Albion Islington intersection will be receiving a red light camera. Construction has already begun and sites should be operational by January 1, 2017. Other locations include Albion Rd at Finch Ave, Albion Road at Kipling Ave, Finch Ave W at Martingrove Rd, and Finch Ave W at Highway 27. These locations were decided based on a citywide review to identify intersections with relatively high numbers of angle collisions. The RLC program has been operating within the City since 1998. The number of angle collisions causing death, serious injury, and property damage have been reduced by over 60%.

STORE FRONT SIGNS

Kindly leave your signs on when open. This increases revenue as customers will know you are open and it will also enhance visibility in our market.

NEW STREET FURNITURE

Our BIA will be receiving four (4) street furniture additions to enhance the feel and look of the area.

BENCH PROGRAM:

As part of the street furniture program, in 2018 the City of Toronto is offering our BIA installation of street benches at no cost. If you would like to request a bench in front of your business (City Property) for 2018 please contact the BIA office and staff will survey your request.

COMMERCIAL FAÇADE PROGRAM

All BIA members are encouraged to participate in the Commercial Façade Program to spruce up the front of your business. The City of Toronto will give you up to \$10,000 (\$12,500 if it is a corner property) to improve the outside of your business. An application must be a minimum of three (3) improvements to qualify for the program including:

- Signage
- Installation & Upgrading of Exterior Lighting
- Brick Cleaning
- Upgrade of exterior windows and doors

Deadline: May 18, 2017, or until funds are all dispersed
